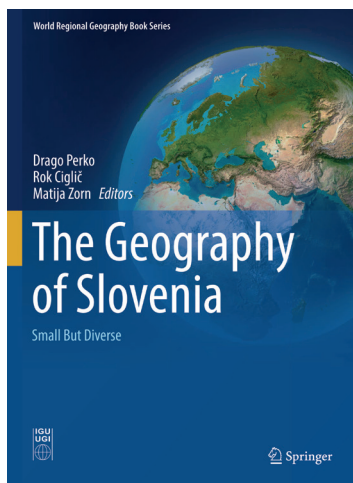

The members of the Association of Slovenian Geographers are independent geographical associations. Their common task is to develop social activities on the one hand and to strengthen geography as a science on the other. The association is also supported by geographical scientific and educational institutions in Slovenia. The association has been publishing the scientific journal **Geographical Bulletin** since 1925 and the professional journal **Geographic Horizon** since 1954.
